APPROPRIATION ACT (CURRENT EXPENDITURES) 2026

BILL NO. 17

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR HONOUR:

We, His Majesty's dutiful and loyal servants, the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Prince Edward Island, towards appropriating the several supplies raised for the exigencies of His Majesty's Government and for the other purposes hereinafter mentioned, do humbly beseech that it be enacted:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Lieutenant Governor and the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Prince Edward Island as follows:

1. There may be paid out of the Operating Fund, a sum not exceeding in the whole Three Billion, Seven Hundred and Ninety-Six Million, Two Hundred and Thirty-Two Thousand, Three Hundred Dollars (\$3,796,232,300) to be applied toward defraying the several current charges and expenses of the Public Service, not otherwise provided for, for the Fiscal Year ending March 31, 2027, as set forth in the Schedule.
2. There may be paid out of the Operating Fund toward defraying the several current charges and expenses of the Public Service, not otherwise provided for, from the expiration of the Fiscal Year ending March 31, 2027, until the passing of the Current Estimates for the Fiscal Year ending March 31, 2028, a sum sufficient based on the Current Estimates for the Fiscal Year ending March 31, 2027.
