**Report of the
Standing Committee on Legislative Assembly Management
on Bill 104**

Honourable Members of the Legislative Assembly,

Pursuant to Sub Section 46 (2) of the Legislative Assembly Act and Rule 67 "Any bill related to the Legislative Assembly or the administration of its offices shall be committed to the Standing Committee on Legislative Assembly Management for consideration and may be brought before the Legislative Assembly in accordance with the procedures for public bills in the Rules of the Legislative Assembly."

On Tuesday, June 20, 2023, Bill 104, An Act to Amend the Ombudsperson Act was introduced and read a first time. Consequently, the Committee met to discuss the potential effects on its jurisdiction this morning.

Recommendation:

While this bill does have implications on the operations of the Legislative Assembly, the Committee recognizes that should the House decide to pass this bill, the Committee will determine how to exercise its powers and duties as outlined in the Rules of the Legislative Assembly and the Legislative Assembly Act.
