## AN ACT TO AMEND THE COMMUNITY CARE FACILITIES AND NURSING HOMES ACT

BILL NO. 101

2026

---

BE IT ENACTED by the Lieutenant Governor and the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Prince Edward Island as follows:

1. **The *Community Care Facilities and Nursing Homes Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. C-13, is amended by the addition of the following after section 11:**

### **11.1 Maximum rate**

- (1) Commencing on July 1, 2026, and on July 1 each year following, the Lieutenant Governor in Council shall establish, by order published in the Gazette, the maximum daily rate that an operator may charge a resident for continual residential accommodation with meals and housekeeping in a facility.

#### **Annual adjustment**

- (2) The maximum daily rate established under subsection (1) shall not be adjusted annually by more than the percentage change, if any, in the all-items Consumer Price Index for Prince Edward Island for the previous calendar year.

#### **Categories of residents or facilities**

- (3) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may establish categories of residents, accommodations or facilities and set different maximum daily rates under subsection (1) for each category.

#### **Prohibition**

- (4) No operator shall charge a resident more than the maximum daily rate established under this section for continual residential accommodation with meals and housekeeping in a facility.

**EXPLANATORY NOTES**

**SECTION 1** adds section 11.1 to the *Community Care Facilities and Nursing Homes Act*, requiring the Lieutenant Governor in Council to establish the maximum daily rate that an operator may charge a resident or category of residents for continual residential accommodation with meals and housekeeping or a category of continual residential accommodations with meals and housekeeping in a facility or category of facilities. It also limits the degree to which the rate may be adjusted annually. It also prohibits an operator from charging a resident more than the maximum daily rate for continual residential accommodation with meals and housekeeping.
