AN ACT TO AMEND THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT

BILL NO. 12 2023

BE IT ENACTED by the Lieutenant Governor and the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Prince Edward Island as follows:

1. Subsection 32(1) of the *Environmental Protection Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. E-9, is amended by the deletion of the words "not less than \$200 or more than \$10,000" and the substitution of the words "not less than \$200 or more than \$50,000".

EXPLANATORY NOTES

SECTION 1 amends subsection 32(1) of the *Environmental Protection Act* to increase the maximum fine that may be imposed under that subsection from \$10,000 to \$50,000.
