An Act to Amend the Prince Edward Island Lands Protection Act

BE IT ENACTED by the Lieutenant Governor and the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Prince Edward Island as follows:

1. Section 21 of the *Prince Edward Island Lands Protection Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. L-5 is amended

(a) by renumbering it as subsection 21(1); and

(b) by the addition of the following:

(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), land conveyed by the Crown or an agent of the Crown is not presumed to be land identified for non-development use if the regulations provide that the Land Identification Program does not apply to that land. Exemption

2. The Act is deemed to have come into force on June 8, 1998.

Commencement

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Section 21 of the Act currently provides that land conveyed by the Crown is presumed to be subject to the development restrictions imposed by the Land Identification Program set out in the regulations, unless the Lieutenant Governor in Council determines otherwise.

The amendment clarifies that certain small amounts of land conveyed by the Crown are not subject to these development restrictions if the land is exempted from the Program in the regulations. This amendment will confirm that applications to the Lieutenant Governor in Council for exemptions from the regulations are not required in respect of these lands.
