An Act to Amend the Fathers of Confederation Buildings Act

BE IT ENACTED by the Lieutenant Governor and the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Prince Edward Island as follows:

1. Subsection 3(3) of the *Fathers of Confederation Buildings Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. F-6 is repealed and the following substituted:

(3) Each of the members of the board shall be appointed for a term not Term of office to exceed three years, except that

- (a) a member may be appointed to fill the remainder of a term when a vacancy occurs;
- (b) the Lieutenant Governor in Council may extend the term of a member of the board for a period not to exceed one year; and
- (c) notwithstanding subsection (2), where the term of a member of the board who is not ordinarily resident in the province is extended pursuant to clause (b), the Lieutenant Governor in Council is not required to consider the views of the board and other persons named in subsection (2).

2. Section 15 of the Act is repealed.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

SECTION 1 enables the transitory initial term provisions for board members to be removed and provides for the extension of a term of office for board members for one year, and in the case of an extension regarding the term of a member not ordinarily resident in the province, the Lieutenant Governor in Council is not required to further consult with the board, Prime Minister or Premiers to make such an extension.

SECTION 2 removes the requirement that the Attorney General must give written consent before a legal action can be commenced against the Trust, the board, any committee or member of the board, or against any employee of the Trust.
