**An Act to Amend the Electoral Boundaries Act**

BE IT ENACTED by the Lieutenant Governor and the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Prince Edward Island as follows:

**1. Section 8 of the *Electoral Boundaries Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. E-2.1 is amended by the deletion of the words “second general election” wherever they occur and the substitution of the words “third general election”.**

**EXPLANATORY NOTES**

The section being amended was added to the Act in 2006 prior to the May 28, 2007 provincial general election. The amendment delays the establishment of an Electoral Boundaries Commission until after the second general election following the May 28, 2007 provincial general election, which will be the third general election since the 2006 amendment.
