AN ACT TO AMEND THE LIQUOR CONTROL ACT

BILL NO. 31

2023

BE IT ENACTED by the Lieutenant Governor and the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Prince Edward Island as follows:

- 1. Subsection 11(1) of the *Liquor Control Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. L-14, is amended**
 - (a) in subclauses (h)(ii), (j)(ii) and (l)(ii), by the addition of the words “or on behalf of” after the words “produced at”; and**
 - (b) in subclauses (h)(iii), (j)(iii) and (l)(iii), by the addition of the words “or on behalf of” after the words “produced by”.**

- 2. This Act comes into force on a date that may be fixed by proclamation of the Lieutenant Governor in Council.**

EXPLANATORY NOTES

SECTION 1 amends subclauses 11(1)(h)(ii), (j)(ii) and (l)(ii), to authorize the holder of a winery, distillery or micro-brewery license, as the case may be, to sell or serve wine, spirits or beer, as the case may be, produced at or on behalf of the winery, distillery or micro-brewery, as the case may be.

It amends subclauses 11(1)(h)(iii), (j)(iii) and (l)(iii), to authorize the holder of a winery, distillery or micro-brewery license, as the case may be, to sell liquor produced by or on behalf of another licensee.

SECTION 2 provides for the commencement of this Act on proclamation of the Lieutenant Governor in Council.
