Allow use of locally cut wood

WHEREAS landowners have always been able to harvest and saw their own wood on PEI;

AND WHEREAS thousands of Island homes have been built from local lumber;

AND WHEREAS the Building Code requirement for stamped and kiln dried lumber often excludes local wood products but does not necessarily mean safer buildings;

AND WHEREAS locally produced lumber is by far the most sustainable building material;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Assembly urge the government to immediately allow the use of unstamped and not kiln dried local wood for single family homes up to three stories.
