**Allow use of locally cut wood**

Ole Hammarlund gives notice that he will move, seconded by Stephen Howard, the following Motion:

**WHEREAS** landowners have always been able to harvest and saw their own wood on PEI;

**AND WHEREAS** thousands of Island homes have been built from local lumber;

**AND WHEREAS** the Building Code requirement for stamped and kiln dried lumber often excludes local wood products but does not necessarily mean safer buildings;

**AND WHEREAS** locally produced lumber is by far the most sustainable building material;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Legislative Assembly urge the government to immediately allow the use of unstamped and not kiln dried local wood for single family homes up to three stories.
