**Exploring alternative models for seniors' living arrangements**

**WHEREAS** the number of seniors on PEI is increasing and is expected to continue to do so for the foreseeable future;

**AND WHEREAS** there are many innovative options for seniors' living that have been adopted in other jurisdictions and which would serve Island seniors well;

**AND WHEREAS** providing a broad continuum of care, from ageing in place to institutional long term care, will better meet the varied needs of Island seniors;

**AND WHEREAS** there are significant potential cost savings in different models of supported living;

**AND WHEREAS** there are broad societal as well as individual benefits to be gleaned from more inclusive and creative models of supportive living;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that this Legislature urge government to develop alternative models of senior care to meet the varied needs of Island seniors.
