## AN ACT TO AMEND THE TIME UNIFORMITY ACT

BILL NO. 128

2020

---

BE IT ENACTED by the Lieutenant Governor and the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Prince Edward Island as follows:

1. **Section 1 of the *Time Uniformity Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. T-3.01, is repealed and the following substituted:**
  1. **Prince Edward Island Time**

There shall be one uniform, official time in use throughout the province, which shall be Prince Edward Island Time, or three hours behind Greenwich Mean Time.
  2. **Section 2 of the Act is repealed.**
  3. **Subsection 23(7) of the *Interpretation Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. I-8, is amended by the deletion of the words “Atlantic Standard time, or four hours behind Greenwich mean time, unless Daylight Saving Time is being observed on that day pursuant to section 2 of the *Time Uniformity Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. T-3.1” and the substitution of the words “Prince Edward Island Time, or three hours behind Greenwich Mean Time”.**
  4. **This Act comes into force on March 15, 2021.**

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

**SECTION 1** amends the *Time Uniformity Act*, to provide for a new standard time for the province named Prince Edward Island Time, which is three hours behind Greenwich Mean Time.

**SECTION 2** repeals section 2 of the *Time Uniformity Act*, which provides for the use of Daylight Saving Time in the province each year.

**SECTION 3** makes a consequential amendment to the *Interpretation Act*, to reflect the change from Atlantic Standard Time to Prince Edward Island Time

**SECTION 4** provides for the commencement of the Act.
