AN ACT TO AMEND THE WORKERS COMPENSATION ACT

BILL NO. 36

2023

BE IT ENACTED by the Lieutenant Governor and the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Prince Edward Island as follows:

1. **Subsection 42(2) of the *Workers Compensation Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. W-7.1, is amended by the deletion of the words “excess of 85%” and the substitution of the words “excess of 90%”.**

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Subsection 42(2) of the *Workers Compensation Act* is amended to authorize the Board to consider collateral benefits a worker is receiving to the extent these benefits together with wage loss benefits payable to the worker have the combined effect of compensating the worker in excess of 90% of the worker’s actual net loss of earning capacity. The amendment increases a worker’s actual net loss of earning capacity from 85% to 90%.
